*Jesus was in the stern asleep on a cushion. They woke him and said to him, "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?" ...the wind ceased and there was great calm...*

We know that God is always with us, he promises to never leave us alone. And yet many times in life we feel that we are alone, that God has abandoned us, that he is nowhere to be found or that he is asleep on a cushion somewhere not noticing the storms around us. It is in those times that we, like the disciples, need to remember to turn to him, to 'wake him up' if you will, to share with him our concern and turn it over to him. 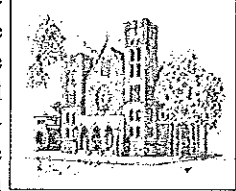

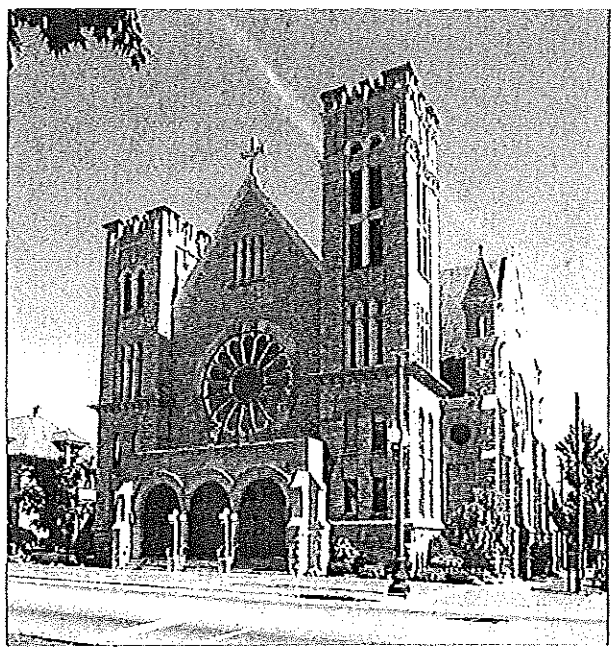
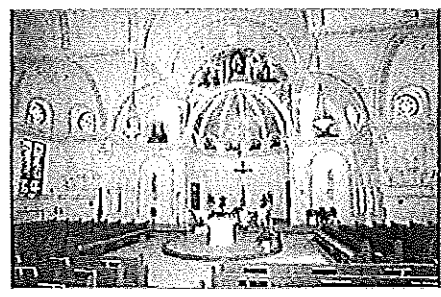
