**CALVERT SENECA TEAMS ACADEMICALLY RANKED IN STATE:**

Calvert Catholic Schools' Athletic Director and Head Boys' Basketball, Ted Willman, and Paul Jones, Head Girls' Basketball, were recently notified by the Ohio High School Basketball Coaches Association (OHSBCA) that our 2008-2009 Calvert Seneca Basketball Teams (boys and girls combined) is ranked 19<sup>th</sup> academically in the State of Ohio out of 1,471 participating high schools. OHSBCA selects and ranks the teams based on the collective GPA of their respective varsities.
