**BECOME THE SAINT YOU WERE CREATED TO BE: Five Steps to Winning the War Within...** St. Mary Adult Faith Formation Committee presents its spring speaker, Dr. John Wood of All Saints Parish on February 13 at 7:00 p.m. in the St. Mary School Rec. Room.

*Dr. John R. Wood grew up in southwest Ohio where he first discovered the war within on the sporting field. John was an Ohio High School state champion in Track and Field in 1998, and went on to the University of Findlay, where he became the 2002 NCAA All-Ohio indoor track champion in the 800m run and a provisional qualifier to the NCAA Division II track and field national championships in the 800m run.*

*John is very active in his faith and his local Catholic parish. John and his wife Kristin lead many ministries at their parish including Adult education, Pre Cana, and a monthly ministry called Fun, Faith, Family. John also coaches Catholic Youth Organization high school basketball, teaches religious education to the high school juniors and seniors at his parish, and is on pastoral council. John is a passionate speaker and has been invited to speak at numerous events and parishes. He has also been a guest on a local radio station to discuss his passion for the Catholic faith. He teaches and speaks on a variety of topics including The Theology of the Body, the Saints, the Church, Mary, and The Great Adventure bible study. He implements the five steps to winning the war within into every topic he speaks on. John and his wife Kristin's dedication to the faith earned them the 2011 Centurion Award from the Diocese of Toledo, given for "Outstanding Service to their parish." He recently began a fund raising program called "26miles, 26souls, 26saints" in which he runs marathons to raise money for charity.*

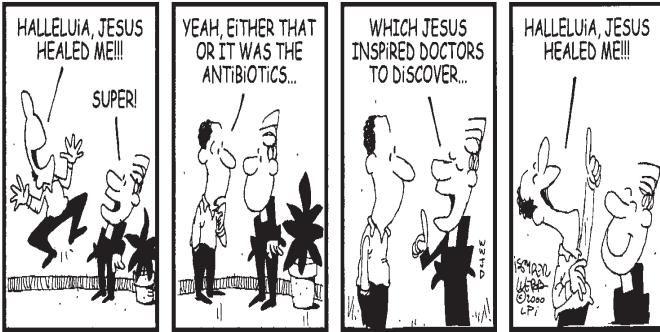
